ETERNAL's aft decks are designed around life close to the water. A broad teak platform creates a substantial waterside area, complemented by an integrated pool and tiered spaces for lounging immediately above the sea. From here, the outdoor areas continue upwards across the yacht, with further spaces for dining, relaxing and enjoying the surroundings. The result is an exterior layout that makes particularly effective use of ETERNAL's 36-metre length.







WELCOME ON BOARD

At 36 metres, ETERNAL has been designed to deliver the space and experience of a significantly larger yacht. Her 299 GT volume creates generous interior proportions alongside expansive outdoor areas and an exceptional connection to the water. A wide 7.70-metre beam contributes to the sense of space on board, while extensive glazing brings light and surrounding views deep into the interiors. From the impressive main deck owner's suite to the multi-level aft areas and waterside pool, ETERNAL makes particularly effective use of every metre.

INTERIORS

Designed by M2 Atelier, ETERNAL's interiors place light, natural materials and connection to the sea at the centre of the experience. Large areas of glazing open the principal living spaces to the surrounding views, while warm woods, tactile finishes and soft architectural forms create a calm, contemporary atmosphere.



The main deck saloon combines generous lounge and dining areas within a sophisticated open setting, reflecting M2 Atelier's focus on spatial flow, transparency and continuity throughout the yacht.
